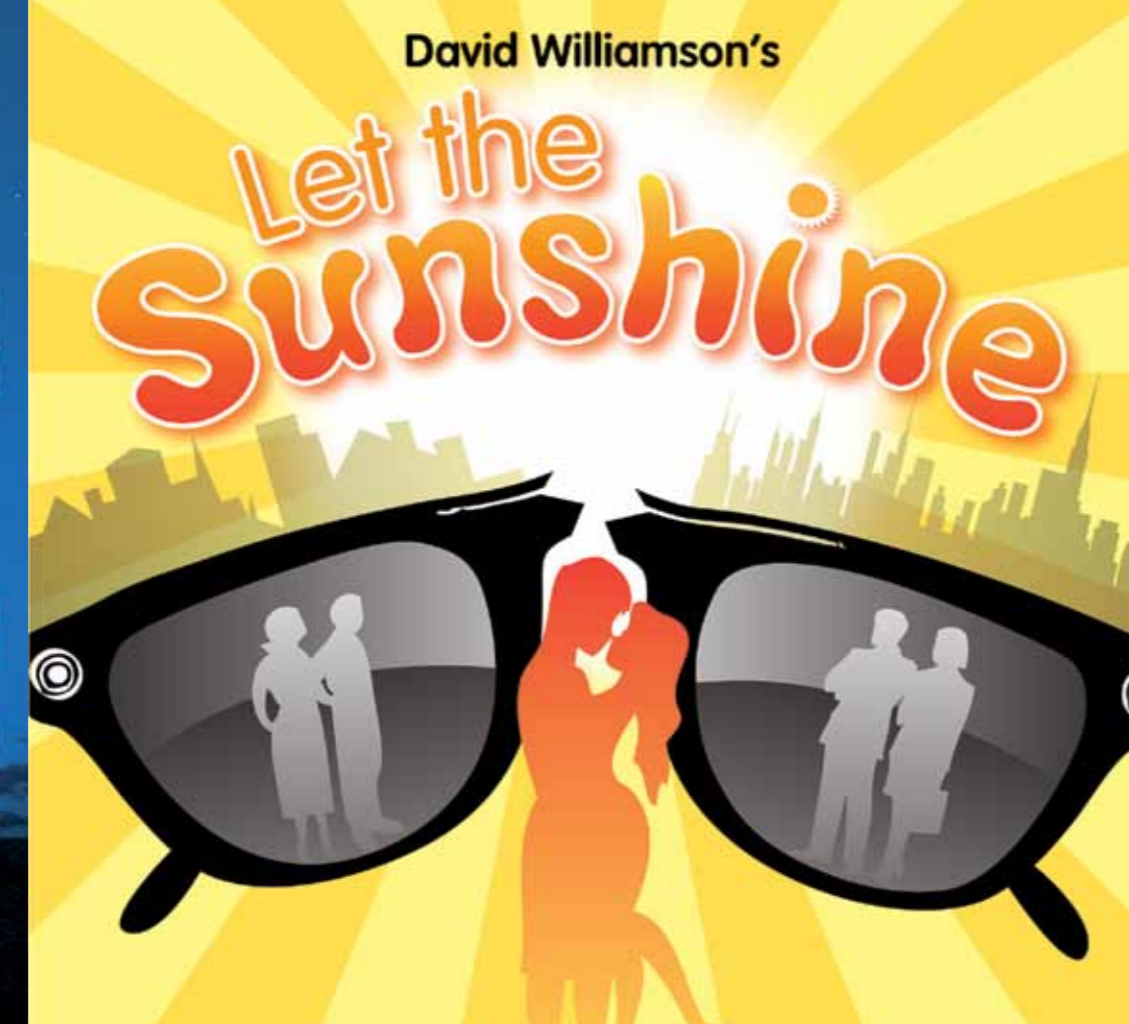


**RED DOG** (PG) 92 MINS

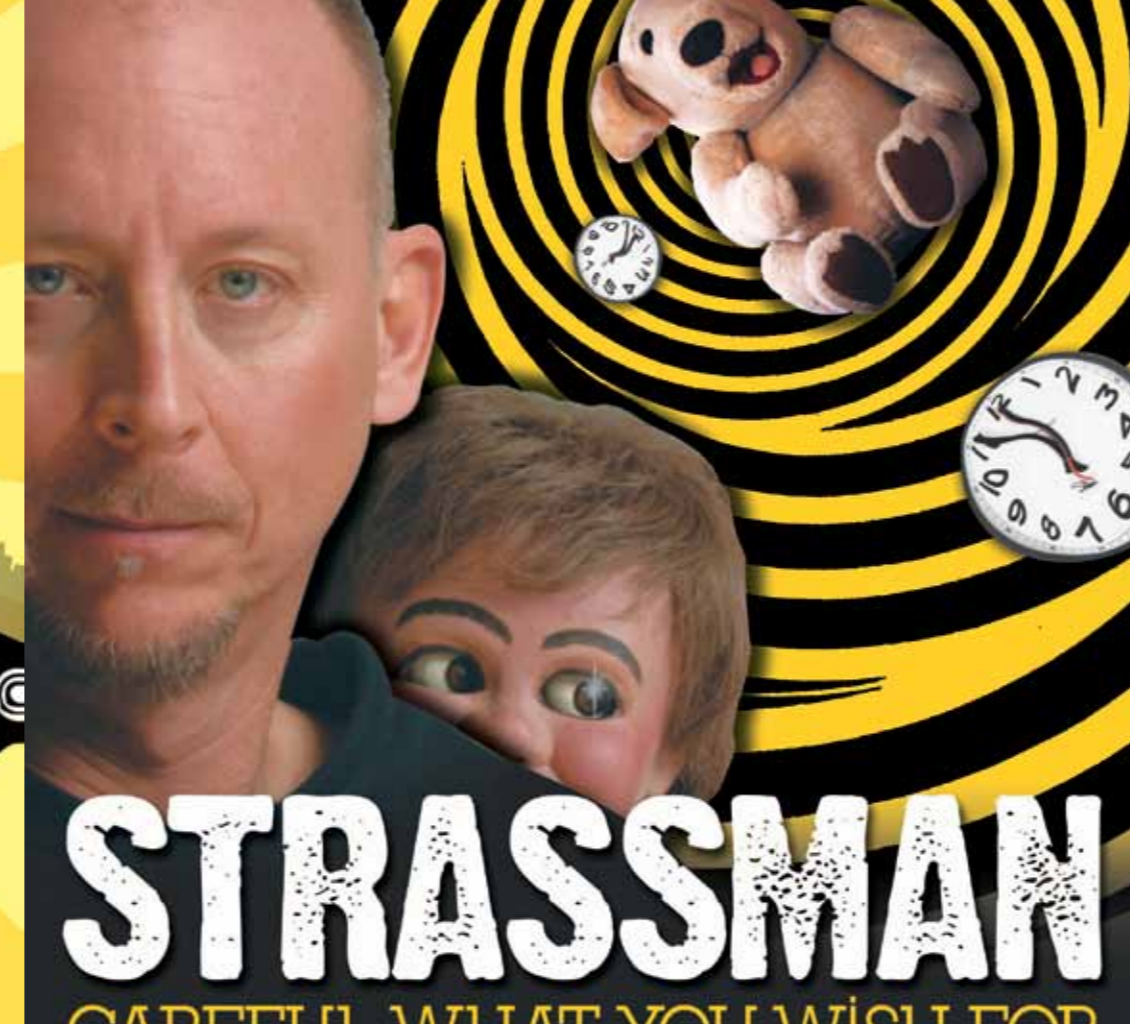
