The due date for renewing your animal's registration is Monday 10 April 2023. All cats and dogs over 3 months old must be registered.

Your pet has a unique reference number. If you choose to pay by telephone, internet or BPAY please take care to check you have used the correct reference number for your animal. This will help ensure payment is allocated to your pet. If paying at post office each pet's notice must be scanned for payment separately.

Your pet's tag is renewable. Paying your renewal notice ensures your pet's current tag is valid to 9 April 2024. Please contact Council if you require a replacement tag.
