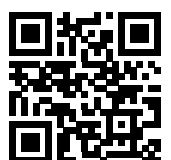
The purpose of the Art for All Exhibition:

International Day of People with Disability (IDPWD) is celebrated on 3 December each year. To help celebrate this day, Latrobe Regional Gallery is holding the Art for All Exhibition to highlight and celebrate the diverse talents of people with disability.

The Art for All Exhibition aims to celebrate the contributions and achievements of people with disability and promote inclusion. It is part of Latrobe Regional Gallery's community art exhibitions which showcases the work of artists in our community at the Gippsland Performing Arts Centre.

Art for All Exhibition guidelines

- An Expression of Interest Form (EOI) must be completed by an entrant for their artwork to be considered for inclusion in the Art for All Exhibition. The EOI form is available on the Latrobe Regional Gallery website or in hard copy from the Latrobe Regional Gallery. Hard copy forms can be posted on request by contacting the Latrobe Regional Gallery.
- The EOI for the Art for All Exhibition is open to people of any age who have disability.
- The Art for All Exhibition will be located at the Latrobe Regional Gallery Satellite Exhibition Site at the Gippsland Performing Arts Centre, at 32 Kay Street Traralgon, Victoria 3844. This location may change depending on the number of EOIs received.
- The Art for All Exhibition is free.
- An entrant can only submit one artwork item to be considered in the Art for All Exhibition. If a group submission is made, those individuals cannot enter a subsequent piece as an individual.
- Artists entering the Art for All Exhibition can select a subject of their choice. There is no theme for the Art for All Exhibition.
- The Art for All Exhibition accepts two-dimensional artworks (drawing, painting, photography, screen printing, poetry, etc.) and sculptural objects (ceramics, glass or mixed media, etc.).
- For two-dimensional artworks, the maximum height and weight of the submission must not exceed 60cm x 60cm and/or 1kg. Works must include D rings on the back for a secure hanging system. Where D rings are not provided, Latrobe Regional Gallery cannot guarantee the artwork will be included in the Art for All Exhibition. Latrobe Regional Gallery may alter the back of two-dimensional artworks to suit the hanging requirements or may be able to provide a frame subject to availability with consent from the entrant.
- For sculptural objects, the maximum size must not exceed 25cm x 25cm. Entrants must advise how they would like their sculpture to be displayed. Clearly mark the top and bottom on the back/underside of your piece.

Terms and Conditions (cont.)

- Artworks entered must be the original work of the artist. Copies of existing artworks will not be accepted.
- By entering the Art for All Exhibition, artists are confirming they are the creator and owner of the entered artwork and have not breached any copyright laws in the creation of the work.
- Artworks entered must be the same as the works received for display.
- Artworks cannot be removed or changed during the Art for All exhibition period.
- Display and placement of the works in the Art for All Exhibition is at the Latrobe Regional Gallery's discretion.
- Artworks that are deemed to be in conflict with the values of Latrobe Regional Gallery and Latrobe City Council, that do not comply with Latrobe Regional Gallery and Latrobe City Council general policies and procedures, poses safety risks or does not meet entry requirements, will not be displayed.
- Artist biography, title of artwork, artwork medium and artwork description/ statement information provided in the EOI form will be used to promote the Art for All Exhibition. Wording may be altered slightly to fit the Art for All Exhibition wording style.
- Failure to comply with any of the above will make an EOI form ineligible.

EOI dates

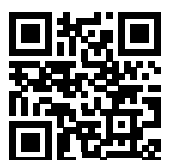
- EOI applications open: 10am on Monday 2 September 2024
- EOI applications close: 4pm on Friday 25 October 2024
- Notification of outcome of EOI applicants to entrants: Wednesday 30 October 2024

Art for All Exhibition dates

- Opening celebration: 11am to 1pm on Friday 6 December 2024
- Exhibition dates: Friday 6 December 2024 to Sunday 2 March 2025

Delivery of artwork

- Artworks must arrive at Latrobe Regional Gallery, located at 138 Commercial Road Morwell, Victoria 3840, between Wednesday 30 October 2024 and Friday 15 November 2024 during opening hours of 10am to 4pm daily. Any pieces not received in this timeframe will not be displayed in the Art for All Exhibition.
- We strongly encourage works to be hand delivered directly to the Latrobe Regional Gallery. Works that are not hand delivered may be posted, but any loss or damage caused to work while in transit is the responsibility of the artist. Any postage costs will be at the expense of the artist.

Terms and Conditions (cont.)

Collection of artwork

- Collection of your artwork must be done in person from Latrobe Regional Gallery, located at 138 Commercial Road Morwell Victoria 3840, between Friday 14 March 2024 and Friday 11 April 2024 during opening hours of 10am – 4pm daily. Please inform Latrobe Regional Gallery staff ahead of time if you are sending another individual to collect your work.

Copyright and reproduction of images

- Successful Art for All Exhibition entrants agree to allow Latrobe Regional Gallery and Latrobe City Council to reproduce (at no charge) images of entered artwork in any publicity or promotion material for the event and future events. This does not affect the artists copyright status of the artwork.
- Images of the successful entrants artwork may be published on both Latrobe Regional Gallery and Latrobe City Council website and social media platforms.

Artwork sales

- On the EOI form, artists can advise if they would like to promote that their exhibited artwork is for sale.
- Artists wanting to promote the sale of their artwork during the Art for All Exhibition will have signage alongside their artwork indicating that their artwork is for sale.
- Interested buyers can visit the Visitor Information Centre co-located at the Art for All Exhibition at the Gippsland Performing Arts Centre to advise of their expression of interest to purchase the artwork. This information will be forwarded to Latrobe Regional Gallery staff to share the interested buyer details with the artist.
- Latrobe Regional Gallery and the Visitor Information Centre will not be involved in the artwork sale process apart from the exchange of interested buyer's details with the artist.
- The transfer of money and artwork will be the responsibility of the artist and the buyer.
